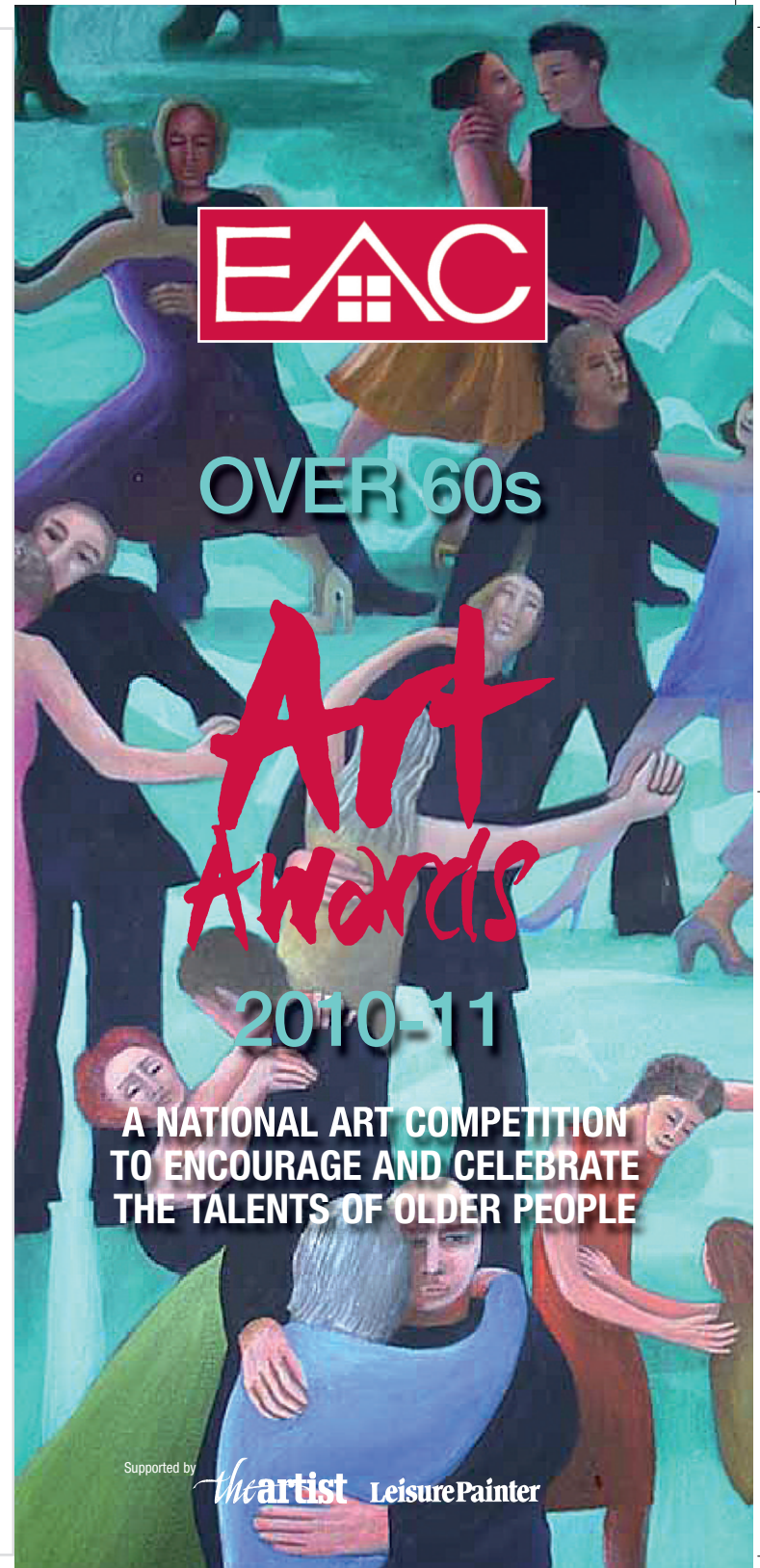

RULES

- Photocopies of the entry form are accepted.
- Entrants must be amateur artists over 60 years of age.
- The work must have been executed after the artist attained the age of 60.
- Work in any medium is accepted, including photography and 3D work. There is no restriction to subject matter.
- Maximum size of original artwork must not exceed 36" x 36" including frame for 2D works, or 36" x 36" x 36" for 3D works.
- If for sale, the price of each work should include a 30% commission to be retained by EAC.
- Hard copy entries should be submitted in the form of colour photograph or laser print reproduction, no larger than A4 in size. PLEASE DO NOT SUBMIT FRAMED ORIGINAL WORKS AT THIS FIRST STAGE, ONLY SEND REPRODUCED IMAGES. Online entries should be uploaded in jpg format with a maximum file size of 5MB.
- Each entry should be labelled clearly with the entrant's name (Surname, First name), and the title of the work. Please include your address on the reverse of images sent as postal entries.
- Each entry must be accompanied by the official entry form (or photocopy) and appropriate fee. A maximum of 5 entries per artist is allowed.
- All entry fees go towards the administration of the competition and will not be refunded if your work is not selected for exhibition.
- Entries cannot be returned unless a stamped addressed envelope is provided with the appropriate paid postage.
- All artists will be informed of the outcome of their entry by 14 March 2011
- If selected for exhibition the entry must be submitted in original format and works on paper must be framed.
- Responsibility for damage or loss, however caused, is the responsibility of the artist. EAC cannot be responsible for any works lost or damaged in the post, or when hung in the exhibition.
- The decision of the judging panel shall be final and EAC will not enter into correspondence with entrants or their representatives.
- The copyright remains with the artist, but EAC retains the right to reproduce the works for publicity purposes for the Art Awards and its exhibitions (including its website) in any format in all territories in perpetuity.



ABOUT EAC OVER 60s ART AWARDS

Now in its 17th year, EAC Over 60s Art Awards is a national art competition that aims to encourage and celebrate the talents of older people. Amateur artists over 60 are invited to enter works in any medium - oil, watercolour, charcoal, pastel, pencil, acrylic, etc. 3D work, textiles and photography are also welcome. Artists may submit more than one entry (maximum 5 entries per person) and group works are also accepted. Entry is £9 per work (inc.VAT) with multiple entry discounts also available (please see the 'How to Enter' section.)

There will be prizes of at least £250 in each of the following categories:

Landscape/Seascape	Photography
Still Life (any medium)	Drawing
Portrait (any medium)	3D Work
Watercolour	EAC People's Choice Award

Angela Farnell Memorial Prizes

Two additional £500 prizes will be awarded in memory of the founder of EAC. These prizes will be for the best entries from artists living in sheltered / retirement housing or a care home, or who entered through a day centre. These prizes are divided between the artist and their sheltered scheme, care home or day centre.

EXHIBITION

Approximately 100 finalists' works will be included in the EAC Over 60s Art Awards Exhibition at The Royal Birmingham Society of Artists' RBSA Gallery, Birmingham B3 1SA, from 10 – 21 May 2011. All exhibiting artists will be invited to a Private View of the exhibition, date to be confirmed, at which prizes will be awarded to the winners. Works can be offered for sale at the exhibition and exhibitors will also have the opportunity to accept commissions for new work. The price of each work should include a 30% commission to be retained by EAC.
